- The total amount of social security and withholding taxes incurred during the pay period at the time of service of this
- The net amount due the defendant, which net amount shall be deemed to be the gross amount less social security and withholding taxes. No assignment, payroll savings plan or other agreement shall be deemed to reduce the net amount due for the purpose of this section.
- The net amount due the defendant from any other salaries, wages or income, including any amounts deducted under any payroil savings plan or agreement.
- Whether you had in your possession or under your control any property debts, or affects belonging to said defendant, at the time of serving the notice, or at the time of answering, or at the time between the date of service and the time fixed herein for answering; and if so, the kind and amount.
